- World cities are the command and control centres in the new global economy and are formed as a result of slow urbanisation.
- They are both a product and cause of economic globalisation. In the past, world cities exported manufactured goods (secondary industry), today they export services and ideas (tertiary industry).
- They are rich in human capital (skills, knowledge, experience) and therefore hold the decision makers of the world.
