structures have been proposed which can be implemented very efficiently. These allow an arbitrary order IIR anti aliasing filter to operate at the lower rate of the decimator interpolator. Similar structures for polyphase IIR decimator interpolator structures are being discussed too. A new approach to digital filter design and implementation has been suggested which speeds up silicon implementation of designs developed in Matlab. The Simulink block description is converted automatically into a bit to bit equivalent VHDL description. This in turn can be compiled simulated synthesized and fabricated without the need to go through the design process twice first algorithmic structural design and then the implementation.
