because it doesn't give the publisher or the original authors very much credit for making the books available I have obliged by removing the original attribution I had added for Creative Commons and by not specifying the publisher's name in my templates for the books What about the titles In August 2013 I was contacted again by the publisher who requested that I remove the books' original titles as well Under the understanding that the books republished here are a Collection and that the title in the book URIs could be considered part of the Section 4 d attribution I have retitled all of the books hosted in this collection Care has been taken to ensure that links to the old names in this collection will redirect to the book's new location and to the same content Further the publisher requested that I remove their corporate trademarks from the books I have therefore also replaced the publisher's name with the phrase Unnamed Publisher and a link to this page And the citations A number of the books in this archive had citations to other books from the publisher or other resources that the publisher was hosting As part of the publisher's requests they asked to have these citations and links removed as well Because it did not appear as though the removal of the citations was likely to impact the books' usability where I have found citations to books from the publisher I have removed those citations as well
