

Armies of the World, 1854-1914 David Woodward, 1978 *MILITARY UNIFORMS IN EUROPE 1900 - 2000 Volume One* R Spencer Kidd, 2013-10-01 This book Volume One gives an historical overview of 36 countries whose armed forces served in Europe 1900 2000 together with uniform descriptions Includes 200 full colour paintings of the regular armies marines airforce and para military troops engaged in land exercises operations and warfare in Europe including non European troops serving in Europe Each entry is accompanied by a history and description of the uniforms illustrated The author and illustrator Ron Kidd has been interested in both police and military history uniforms and insignia since he was a school boy in the 1950 s He has visited over 300 police and military museums world wide and has written and illustrated a number of magazine articles on both police and military history and uniforms He is a member of both the Military Heraldry Society and the Military Historical Society It is anticipated that Volume Two will be published in 2013 *The French Army in the Great War* David Bilton, 2019-06-30 A history of the fighting and day to day lives of French soldiers on the Western Front in World War I filled with rare archival photos Few books have been written in English about the French Army during the Great War and those that exist feature very few illustrations This book aims to provide a highly readable and succinct account of the work of the French Army on the Western Front as well as provide the reader with a wealth of photographs that show the daily life of the French soldier both in and out of the trenches All of the images are contemporary many coming from wartime and postwar magazines interspersed with many previously unpublished images The book aims to give a concise overview of the war seen through French eyes and includes the casualties incurred Although the May 1917 mutinies were an important but brief part of the story they are not dealt with at length because they can distract from the main story of the valor shown by the French troops in battles where the casualties were extremely high Also included is a lengthy introduction that explains the structure of the army at the onset of the war and some of the problems it faced as well as a section that looks at the uniforms worn and how they changed during the war *Combined Arms Warfare in the Twentieth Century* Jonathan Mallory House, 2001 For centuries the world has witnessed the development and use of increasingly complex and powerful military systems and technologies In the process the art of war has truly become the art of combined arms warfare in which infantry artillery air support intelligence and other key elements are all coordinated for maximum effect Nowhere has this trend been more visible than in the history of twentieth century warfare Originally published as an essential in house study for U S Army officers during the 1980s this much revised and expanded edition remains the most complete study available on the subject Rewritten with a much wider readership in mind it both retains its enormous practical utility for military professionals and provides a valuable and appealing introduction for scholars and general readers Jonathan House author of the original work brings the story of combined arms up to the present covering among other things Desert Storm the war in Chechnya and the rise of smart weapons and related technologies He traces the evolution of tactics weapons and
