

The Coevolutionary Process John N. Thompson, 2009-04-24 Traditional ecological approaches to species evolution have frequently studied too few species, relatively small areas, and relatively short time spans. In *The Coevolutionary Process*, John N. Thompson advances a new conceptual approach to the evolution of species interactions: the geographic mosaic theory of coevolution. Thompson demonstrates how an integrated study of life histories, genetics, and the geographic structure of populations yields a broader understanding of coevolution or the development of reciprocal adaptations and specializations in interdependent species. Using examples of species interactions from an enormous range of taxa, Thompson examines how and when extreme specialization evolves in interdependent species and how geographic differences in specialization, adaptation, and the outcomes of interactions shape coevolution. Through the geographic mosaic theory, Thompson bridges the gap between the study of specialization and coevolution in local communities and the study of broader patterns seen in comparisons of the phylogenies of interacting species.

Thompson, 2005-06-15 Coevolution, reciprocal evolutionary change in interacting species driven by natural selection, is one of the most important ecological and genetic processes organizing the earth's biodiversity. Most plants and animals require coevolved interactions with other species to survive and reproduce. *The Geographic Mosaic of Coevolution* analyzes how the biology of species provides the raw material for long-term coevolution, evaluates how local coadaptation forms the basic module of coevolutionary change, and explores how the coevolutionary process reshapes locally coevolving interactions across the earth's constantly changing landscapes. Picking up where his influential *The Coevolutionary Process* left off, John N. Thompson synthesizes the state of a rapidly developing science that integrates approaches from evolutionary ecology, population genetics, phylogeography, systematics, evolutionary biochemistry, and physiology and molecular biology. Using models, data, and hypotheses to develop a complete conceptual framework, Thompson also draws on examples from a wide range of taxa and environments, illustrating the expanding breadth and depth of research in coevolutionary biology.
