and future technologies is substantial if the surrounding environment can be stabilized This paper summarizes the effects of a warming climate upon archaeological sites and uses the Arctic as a focal point as it is the northern regions that are currently recognized as the most environmentally vulnerable The Sannirut site on Bylot Island Nunavut presents an excellent case study on the importance of preservation policies as well as the practicalities on how it can be done with current technologies
