Back in the 1960s, tackling poverty in place meant focusing resources in the inner city and in rural areas. The phenomenon raises several daunting challenges, such as the need for more and better transportation options, services, and financial resources. But necessity also produces opportunity. In this case, the opportunity to rethink and modernize services, structures, and procedures so that they work in more scaled, cross-cutting, and resource-efficient ways to address widespread need.
