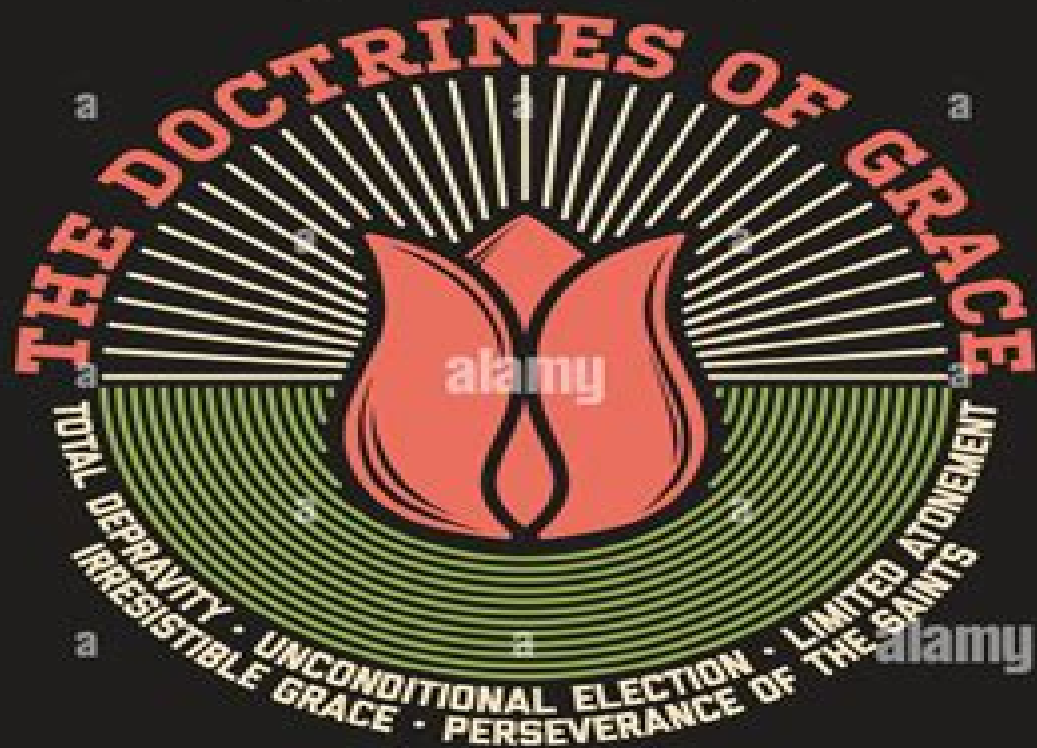

In his chapters on Righteousness in Sinners and Sin in Believers, he maintains that the full Christian doctrine is nowhere drawn out in the New Testament but that it may be deduced from scattered references. In his discussion of Sin in Believers, he claims that Paul taught what some may consider a heresy, namely, that in what may be called conversion baptism, a believer was wholly cleansed from sin. In many ways, this volume is complementary to Dr. Smith's last volume, *The Bible Doctrine of Sin*, and like all his work, it is the fruit of sound knowledge, deep scholarship, and penetrating insight. *The Doctrines of Grace from the Lips of Our Lord* J.
