

force a tense showdown that would test their mettle In response to the blockade the British Americans Canadians and other Allies had no choice but to either acquiesce or break the blockade by air hoping correctly that the Soviets wouldn't dare shoot down planes being used strictly for civilian purposes Over the course of the next year over 200 000 flights were made to bring millions of tons of crucial supplies to West Berlin with the Allies maintaining a pace of landing a plane in West Berlin every 30 seconds at the height of the Airlift As the success of the Berlin Airlift became clear the Soviets realized the blockade was ineffective and both sides were able to save face by negotiating an end to the blockade in April 1949 with the Soviets ending it officially on May 12 The Airlift would technically continue until September but for all intents and purposes the first crisis of the Cold War had come to an end and most importantly the confrontation remained cold For the next decade West Berlin remained a haven for highly educated East Germans who wanted freedom and a better life in the West and this brain drain was threatening the survival of the East German economy In order to stop this access to the West through West Berlin had to be cut off so in August 1961 Soviet premier Nikita Khrushchev authorized East German leader Walter Ulbricht to begin construction of what would become known as the Berlin Wall The wall begun on Sunday August 13 would eventually surround the city in spite of global condemnation and the Berlin Wall itself would become the symbol for Communist repression in the Eastern Bloc
