Amazon Adventure John Emil Becker, PH D,2021-05-03 Traveling to the Amazon Rainforest to learn about the wildlife that inhabit the Upper Amazon region of Peru was one of the most memorable experiences of my life AMAZON ADVENTURE is the story of my incredible journey through the world s most spectacular rainforest From the moment I flew into the regional capital city of Iquitos until I returned to the United States my travels on the world s greatest river the Amazon and its tributaries my trip included one thrilling moment of discovery after another Racing down the Amazon River in a fast boat from Iquitos to the isolated Explorama Lodge nestled deep in the rainforest I was amazed by sheer number of plants and animals that call this part of the world home Iquitos is located 2 200 miles from the Atlantic Ocean yet the river is so wide at that point that you can barely see one shore to the other further downstream as the river gets bigger and bigger and bigger you can sail down the middle of the river and not see either shoreline Altogether the river is over 4 000 miles long and over its long journey from a small stream high in Andes Mountains in Peru until it finally empties into the Atlantic the Amazon River contains an unbelievable diversity of animal life including stingrays electric eels bull sharks lungfish pink river dolphins manatees caiman reptiles related to alligators and crocodiles as well as more different species of fish than live in the Atlantic Ocean As I traveled through the lush green rainforest with my guide Roldan I saw a vast array of rainforest animals from quick moving spider monkeys to barely moving sloths as well as tapirs capybaras poison dart frogs and many other living creatures One highlight of this part of my trip was seeing the bright blue wings of a morpho butterfly flash past and observing a giant wasp dragging a young tarantula across the forest floor After thoroughly exploring the area surrounding the Explorama Lodge we boarded another boat and traveled to the Amazon Center for Environmental Education and Research ACEER to learn about the important work they are doing to preserve the Amazon Rainforest and the plants and animals that call the Amazon home Undoubtedly the most exciting part of our visit was our walk along the ACEER s canopy walkway Swaying back and forth as went higher and higher into the canopy gave us a view of the rainforest that was incredibly beautiful and thrilling at the same time Reaching the highest point of the walkway at 180 feet we found ourselves looking down at the tops of 100 foot tall trees Once we left the ACEER site we found ourselves back on the water and it wasn t long before we had yet another amazing experience As we cruised along in our small boat suddenly we heard a loud splash When we turned around to see what would make such a loud noise we saw a large river dolphin shoot out of the water in a playful leap What a sight The final leg of my amazing journey through Peru s Upper Amazon region was aboard an fantastically beautiful boat named La Amatista This large river boat was complete with luxury woodlined cabins and views of the surrounding rainforest that looked like something straight out of a magazine Each day we would sail out from La Amatista in small boats to explore the tributaries of the Amazon River On one such trip early one morning we were greeted by the loud barking sounds of a tree filled with large red howler monkeys They weren t happy with our incursion into their

territory and were not afraid to let us know about it On yet another side trip in our small boats we tied up on some trees in a black water lagoon where we used impromptu fishing poles to fish for a local favorite red belly piranhas Being that close to water filled with the hungry vicious swimming teeth gave new meaning to the locals saying Sometimes you eat the piranha and sometimes the piranha eats you

The Land Beyond Time is a non stop fast paced action packed adventure that takes place in the jungles of the Amazon River It is a story about traitors sabotage espionage greed hate love and romance cold blooded murder and justice It is the story about the trials and tribulations of a dozen human beings whos sabotaged aircraft crashes into the Amazon jungle The crash survivors 6 men and 6 women including 2 drug cartel bosses being extradited to the US now must compete against their individual fears each other and those unknown unexplained challenges facing them in the hot wet dangerous jungle The terrifying but strange animals that abound there like the giant spiders boars anacondas and crocodiles two hostile tribes and the headhunters a Colombian drug cartel group of professional killers coming to rescue their bosses and a small but elite team of US Marines conducting search and rescue operations for the crash survivors all are tossed together in the jungles of the Amazon Our adventure begins during December 1999 in Lima Peru when a US military aircraft C141 preparing to take a number of government passengers back to the US is commandeered by an Embassy official He orders the aircraft to take on 10 additional passengers including two recently captured Colombian drug lords being extradited to the US Hours into the flight the plane is sabotaged by someone onboard and it crashes into the Amazon River dumping the survivors into the hostile terrain north of Manaus Brazil Two of the 12 crash survivors are immediately separated from the main group and have adventures of their own to contend just to remain alive The remaining survivors are captured by one of two hostile tribes the Ingou and Sangou The survivors are taken to the Ingou village and interrogated while second tribe prepares to attack the Ingou village to prevent an escaped prisoners arrival there who possesses information which could change the delicate balance of power in the jungle Back in Peru an Embassy official is fingered as an espionage agent for the major drug cartel The official gets nervous and runs to his new bosses in Colombia Meanwhile the cartel sends 24 professional killers to retrieve their two drug bosses from the sabotaged aircraft Their additional instructions are to eliminate all the remaining passengers When the aircraft fails to show up at Manaus as planned the cartels killers immediately begin a search pattern and within hours of finding the crashed aircraft their journey begins Back in Lima the Non Commissioned Officer in Charge NCOIC of the Marine Security Guard MSG Detachment a friend of Al Ranlom a former Marine who is aboard the missing aircraft hears of the espionage and the plane crash Not one to stand by and watch the NCOIC forms an unofficial search and rescue team which picks up the trail of the missing craft and her survivors The dangers to all involved the survivors the cartels professional killers and the Marine Security Detachment rescuers are found in every turn they take They are all around them in the trees at ground level on under and above the waterways swamps and mangroves These hazards eat away

at their self confidence and tears at their moral fabric They are tested continuously passing one test only to encounter another challenge If it isnt attacks by giant spiders anacondas and crocodiles its tigers flesh eating worms and blood sucking bats Or its problems from hostile tribes or from the natural environment like earthquakes and lava flows or from the failure of their sophisticated equipment like the GPS systems radios and walkie talkie
