RULES OF STRESS

- A. When a word ends in a vowel, *a* or *e*, the stress falls on the next-to-the last syllable:
casa *Bos* (house), *ma*ma (mother), *ciudad* (city).
B. When a word ends in a consonant, except *n* or *s*, the stress falls on the last syllable:
*pa*pel (paper), *ciudad* (city).
C. When the pronunciation of a word does not conform to any of the above rules, a written accent is required to indicate which syllable to stress:
coffee, *tree*.
D. Sometimes written accents are used to distinguish the function or the meaning between two words with the same spelling:
1. *es* (yes, familiar, subject pronoun) and *ese* (your, possessive adjective)
 2. *de* (verb to give) and *de* (the preposition)
 3. *el* (you) and *il*
 4. Certain pronouns such as *yo*, *tú*, *él*, *ella*, *usted*, *nosotros*, *vosotros*, *ellos*, *ellas*, *ustedes* must always have a written accent.

SYLLABIFICATION

- A. A vowel or a vowel combination can constitute a syllable.
1. Digraphs and triphthongs are considered a single syllable. *example: content* has divided it: *con-tent*, *di-an-ty* (content); *a-lter-nate* (ground-mother).
- B. Two strong vowels (a, e, o) do not form a diphthong and are separated into two syllables: *ex-ample* (job); *re-a-l-ize* (reality).
- C. A written accent on a weak vowel (l, u) breaks the diphthong:
1. Thus the vowels are separated into two syllables: *re-l-ax* (relaxing); *di-a-ry* (day).
- D. A single consonant forms a syllable with the vowel that follows it: *ma-de-ra* (della); *an-na-les* (Annales).
1. Note: *re* is considered a single consonant: *pe-ter* (dog); *ma-rynn* (Maryann).
- E. When two consonants appear between two vowels, they are separated into syllables: *ma-ter-nal* (Maternity); *car-ta* (letter).
1. Exception: if b, c, d, f, g, p or t are followed by l or r (when silent), a *pre-nal* (the word).
- F. When there are two consonants appear between two vowels, only the last one is included in the following syllable: *ma-de-ra* (maternal); *tra-n-si-er* (no transfer).
1. Exception: if b, c, d, f, g, p, or t are followed by l or r (when silent), *tra-n-si-er* (transfer).

CAPITALIZATION

1. Countries, persons, continents, and the first word of a title are **never** capitalized.

NOUNS
GENDER

Nouns are either feminine or masculine, whether they refer to a person, place, thing or quality, and are usually accompanied by an article.

- A. Most nouns ending in *-ary* masculine: all letters (the books), but there are exceptions such as *la mano* (the hand), *la mente* (the intellect).
- B. Some nouns ending in *-um* which refer to non-concrete things are masculine: all cities (the cities), all dramas (the dramas), all illnesses (the illnesses), all poems (the poems), all problems (the problems), all programs (the programs), all sciences (the sciences), all terms (the terms).
- C. Most nouns ending in *-a* are feminine: la mano (the hand), with exceptions such as all maps (the maps), all stars (the stars).
- D. Nouns ending *idea*, *-idad*, *-idad*, *-idad*, *-ness* are feminine: la cultura (the culture), la esperanza (the expectation), la libertad (the freedom), la felicidad (the happiness), la juventud (the youth), la salud (the health).

PLURAL

- A. If the noun ends in:
1. a vowel, add -a: *libros/libros, pascuas/pascuas*
 2. a consonant, add -as: *países/países, profesores/profesores*
 3. -a, change it to -as: *amigas/amigas, hijas/hijas, hermanas/hermanas*

ARTICLES

Agree in gender and number with the noun that they accompany.

1. Declinable articles [el, la, los, las (other)] occur.
2. With *el* (and/or) used on nouns, particularly at beginning of a sentence. *El* continues as *los*. (Following is good.)
3. With *los* limited to a noun. Phrases of *libros*, of *construccion* y *la* *phases* *adhere* to *los*. (I put the book, the notebook, and the pen on the table.)
4. With certain nouns such as *estancia*, *casita*, *ciudad* where English omits the article. *Los* *Indians* was a *la* *ciudad*. (There's go the *Indians*. *Los* *Indians* *aparecen* *muchos* on the *cerro*. *El* *Indiano* *hace* a *lot* in *band*.)
5. The identity of an invariable concept. *Los* *bandes* as *mas* *bandes*. (Indians in a variety.)
6. To identify something specific that precedes a demonstrative adjective. *El* *muchacho* *dice*. *un* *tiempo* *despues*.

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7. With means of weight or pressure: *Las mariposas vuelaban no shibier la fibra.* (The winged ones came (down) over you.)
 8. With verbs, nouns, and professions when used with a possessive: *Las doctores García Hamón.* (The doctors called.)
 9. With means of motion: *El doctor la bilateria.* (I study bilaterally.)
 10. With signs of the month, indicating when something occurs: *where we see "sun" in English.* *Ja, where summer of other of autumn.* (Sometimes we go to the movies on Saturday.)
 11. With parts of the body or articles of clothing, especially if the possession is clearly indicated as in the case of reflexive verbs: *Me pongo all abrigos.* (I put on my coat.)
 12. With the names of the things: *En la primavera bilera viene el calor.* (Spring brings the heat.)
 13. The above possession: *El abrigos del and the primavera están en el mundo.* (The weather's most in in the climate.)
 14. With names of certain cities, countries, and continents: *In Argentina, los Estados Unidos, la Habana, la América del Sur.*
 15. With a proper noun modified by an adjective: *el propicio Jefe el último domingo.*
 16. With an inanimate object in possession: *Sometimes la mariposa bilateria.* (We North Americans.)
 17. Possession being when telling time: *En la casa.* (It is one o'clock.)
 18. Note: The masculine singular form of the definite article, *el*, is used before certain feminine nouns that begin with stressed *al* or *aguala* (roughly, of agree (sweet)).
- B. Indefinite articles:
1. *una, unas, unos, unos* (i.e., never) normally precede a noun.
 2. In specific cases an article is not used:
 - a. *una* is not used for *el* when the noun following it is not modified. *Yo soy profesor.* (I am a teacher professor.)

ADVERBS

- A. Modify a verb, an adjective or another adverb.
1. To form an adverb add *-mente* to feminine singular form of adjective: *correcto* - *correctamente* (correctly).
 2. An adverb precedes the adjective it modifies but normally follows the verb it modifies: *La profesora es muy inteligente.* (The professor is very intelligently. / She is very intelligent.)
Ellos pronuncian bien. (They pronounce well.)
