Magurran, 2013-04-17 Although diversity is one of the central themes of ecology there is considerable disagreement about how it should be measured I first encountered this problem 10 years ago when I started my research career and spent a long time pouring over the literature in order to find the most useful techniques The intervening decade has seen a further increase in the number of papers devoted to the topic of ecological diversity but has led to no consensus on how it should be measured My aim in writing this book is therefore to provide a practical guide to ecological diversity and its measurement In a quantitative subject such as the measurement of diversity it is inevitable that some mathematics are involved but at all times these are kept as simple as possible and the emphasis is constantly on ecological reality and practical application I hope that others entering the fascinating field of ecological diversity will find it helpful This book grew out of my work in The School of Biological and Environmental Studies at the New University of Ulster Coleraine Northern Ireland I am indebted to all the ecologists there for providing a stimulating atmosphere Foremost among these were Arian Macfadyen and Palmer Newbould A number of the figures and tables in the book are based on data collected in Northern Irish woodlands
