1985 For decades the neighborhoods have been home to some of Savannah's most prominent families. Former residents include media mogul Ted Turner and the University of Georgia bulldog mascot owned by Frank W. Sonny Seiler. Within these pages are photographs from private collections never before made available to the public: images of Savannahians at work and at play. Captivating scenes of days long ago reveal the history of a much beloved community.
