



Instead they were written especially for it. We had before us from the beginning the goal of creating a synthesis of interest to students of environmental adaptation but adaptation broadly construed and to one of the world's difficult environments the boreal forest. No species has left a clearer path through time than has ours and none has made its way through such a diversity of challenging environments.
