

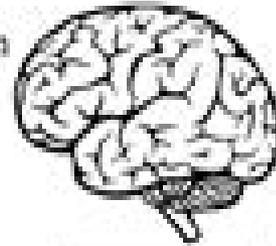
Patterns of Brain Aging

Green = related to maintained cognition


↑ = activation

↓ = suppression



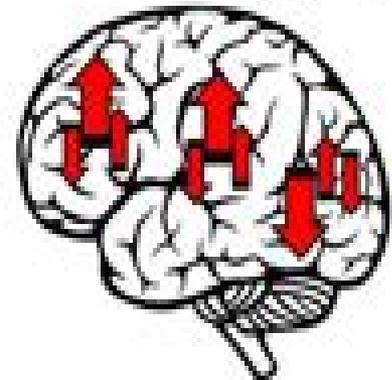




