in doing what I take for granted and it changed my perspective on technology and what it means to be human Looking back it was clear from an early age that I accepted all people recognised individuals and gained the realisation that everyone had strengths and limitations Through my design training at school college and then university I was able to frame questions about what does it mean to be human Ergonomics and Anthropometrics is what started me on questioning why technologies were not measurable against who uses them and their physical emotional and intelligence limitations If that s offensive think about it everyone has limitations they also have strengths certainly I have benefited by having to work harder with reading and writing than others through being able to make connections others cannot see I m not special just different
