Suggested Lesson Procedure:

First, explain the difference in a VO (Voice Over), VOTD (Voice Over + Text on Display) and text (voice) story. You can use my [VO to Broadcast](#) lesson to highlight the differences and their examples.

Assign students to use one or all of the facts and quotes provided to write each type of story. Stories should start with some kind of hook that includes the most relevant and important information first. Sentences need to be short and conversational.

Remind students that in text broadcast, you write a story the reader can see, although there are certain details or pieces of information that would absolutely be included in a story (who, what, where, when, why).

When students are finished, you can have them read their stories aloud so they would be read in a broadcast or video story to your students (or both).
