adolescent psychiatrists and mental healthcare providers While a text certainly cannot single handedly compensate for such a workforce shortage it could potentially help to mitigate the negative impact on patients by facilitating early identification and treatment in the primary care setting Additionally with more effective treatment in pediatric settings less complex cases may be addressed before specialty care is needed and the expertise of child and adolescent psychiatrists can be more effectively used for more complex cases Pediatric Psychiatry in Primary Care is the ultimate resource for clinicians working with children including pediatricians family physicians general psychiatrists psychologists early career child psychiatrists social workers nurses school counselors and all clinical professionals who may encounter children struggling with psychiatric disorders
