3. He provides a Story Chart or Literary Map of each New Testament book that gives the reader a visual of the overall flow of each New Testament book. This is extremely helpful in that it helps the reader follow the storyline in books like the Gospels and Acts and to trace the argument that is being made in each New Testament letter.
4. He then provides a walkthrough of each New Testament book passage by passage, helping the reader understand how each New Testament book fits together as a coherent whole.
5. Finally, in the corresponding BCBS Reader's Guide to the New Testament Workbook, Anderson provides study/discussion questions for the reader as he/she reads through each book in the New Testament. The workbook can be used in individual study, a Sunday School or Bible Study small group, or a high school Bible class.
