Axiology is the philosophical study of value

Concerns values, ethics and aesthetics

Aesthetics, i.e., beauty and harmony, is a main concern

Ethics is a sub-field of axiology

ETHICS

Ethics is the philosophical study of morality and moral principles

Concerns morality or the right conduct

Aesthetics is not a major concern
