Alston, 1989 Epistemic Justification collects twelve distinguished and influential essays in epistemology by William P Alston taken from a body of work spanning almost two decades They represent the gradual development of Alston's thought in epistemology He concentrates on topics that are central to contemporary epistemology and provides a much needed and useful map to these issues by explicitly distinguishing and interrelating concepts of justification used in epistemology More important he develops and defends his own distinctive epistemic view throughout the volume Notably he argues for an account of justification that combines both internalist and externalist features In addition he discusses various forms of foundationalism and supports a moderate form Finally Alston demonstrates that the epistemic circularity that often plagues our attempts to validate our basic sources of belief does not prevent our showing that they are reliable sources of knowledge
